Discussion notes	Joaquin: • Dealing with children, they are primarily causing issues at farmers market. • Ambassadors have collaborated w/LSD & LPD to create a curfew to children. • Finding people in trash enclosures, at RIO. • Many people are being found smoking and plugged into electricity charging their phones. • Wellness check increases due to heat + substance abuse • Increase of people lingering at ARCO, RIO and at the wellness centers. • Tarzana has been assisting ambassadors with outreach information. They are not having an outreach issue, the issue is the individuals not continuing with the help after. • Thursday's library provides help. • They have been having a reoccurring issue with an African American man with dreads. Twice in a row he has started a fight at the Farmers Market. Roshelle (LPD):

They want to check in and see if this was a onetime occurrence or if it's something LPD needs to be on the lookout for. Email stated that it was difficult to enjoy his meal because the BLVD was too loud. - This 4th of July was the first year that Fireworks Prohibition was enforced. They confiscated 3,000 lbs. of fireworks. And had 3 arrests. - National Night out is next month, they have 20 of 30 vendors. - If anybody wants to contribute to a raffle basket, please contribute ASAP
Questions or concerns	Sam: (To Joaquin) - Can we ask the city to shut off electricity? Response: They have done that in the past, but it became an issue when needing power - Anything that would make your job easier? Response: More guards. Ashley for Arbor Apartments: (To Joaquin) - Is having issues with the man with dreads, she states that he is scary. She is also having issues with a kid who she believes is runaway. He hangs around the complex, pulls fire alarm and tries to open tenant doors. Response: Joaquin mentioned that the guards can patrol as a curtesy and gave her his card. Roshelle asked her to please send over any and all documentation/ pictures she has so that they can take action. That she will send over officers to speak to children. Open discussion to Roshelles update: - Theres a group of guys that hangout at the benches in front of Lucky Luke. They smoke and listen to music. They are there at different times of day and depending on whose is at the restaurants at the time depends on whether or not there are complaints about them.
